Fabio Zanon at the West Sussex Guitar Club

On Saturday 7th June, a group of DGS members visited our friends at the West Sussex Guitar Club to see the performance of the Brazilian guitarist Fabio Zanon.

Fabio presented a very enjoyable programme, with music composed by a variety of 19th century composers.

The evening started with two Spanish Dances and Tonadilla: Le Maja de Goya, written by Enrique Granados. The piece was written originally for voice and piano.




The first half was completed with Variations and Fugue on "Folia de España", written by Manuel Ponce. The first time Fabio shifted away from the 19th century came at the beginning of the second half, with J.S. Bach's Prelude, Fugue and Allegro BWV 998. This work has become one of Bach's most celebrated works on the classical guitar, and Fabio did not disappoint. The fugue was played with perfect attention to the voicing, and the allegro was played at a blistering pace, without any sacrifice to accuracy.

Fabio then returned to the 19th century with Mazurka by Alexander Tansman, and the programme was completed with Four Etudes by Francisco Mignone. The etudes presented some beautiful lyrical phrases as well as very fast passages. The audience then demanded to hear more, and Fabio did not disappoint, as he performed four encores, to end another great night of music at WSGC.

DGS May Meeting

The DGS meeting in May provided a wide range of music from the guitar repertoire. Peter Collinson started with Danza del Altiplanto and Capricio Arabe. written by two well known composers for the guitar, Leo Brouwer and Francisco Tarrega. Richard then performed Song Without Words by John Williams, followed by Sue and Bob's performance of Scarborough Fair and a Hommage to Paco de Lucia. Andy played Broadway and Hoe Down by John Duarte and Chris and John finished the afternoon with Pavan A written by Rosen Muller.




