

Judicael Perroy Recital

We have been fortunate to have the opportunity to host a concert by French guitarist Judicael Perroy later this month on the 24th January 2016. We are very fortunate to be able to have Judicael perform as he is playing for the West Sussex Guitar Club the evening before. This means we can save a little expense by sharing his travel expenses with them. It is short notice but we are hoping that many of you will be available to support us and attend the concert. The committee have decided to try a different venue as Kinson has never brought in any extra audience numbers apart from members in the past despite best efforts to advertise in the locality. We were all hoping that the Lantern Church in Merley would be our centre for concerts but the organisers at the Church have decided not to allow the hall to be hired beyond church related events. So this time we have decided to try **Brockenhurst Village Hall** in the New Forest. It has excellent rail connections and the hall is very close to the station. We are aware that this is not the most central venue and will be a bit of a drive for some of our West Dorset members but perhaps some car sharing could be used? This could be discussed at the 'social evening' on the 16th Jan. We will likely be exploring some alternative venues for forthcoming concerts in an attempt to find a suitable base for our events so if any of you have any suggestions then please do let us know!

'Born in 1973 in Paris, he began playing the guitar at age 7 attending the Conservatoire Municipal Inter-districts of Paris. He studied with Delia Estrada and Raymond Gratien at the Ecole Nationale

d'Aulnay-sous-Bois where he graduated with honors. At age 11, he performed as soloist in two concertos by Vivaldi with Ensemble Instrumental du Mans, under the direction of André Girard and continued his musical studies with Roberto Aussel and Daniel Lavielle. At 14, he won second prize at the International guitar competition of Ile de France. In 1992, he won the grand prize and audience prize at the 15th Concours international de guitare René Bartoli by unanimous jury decision. In 1994, he received Licence de Concert from Ecole Normale de Musique in Paris from Alberto Ponce's class and later that year he was awarded the 1st prize at the 7th International Competition of Bourg-Madame where the final vote was by the general public without any jury. In 1996, he was the first prize winner of his graduating class at the National Conservatory of Music and Dance in Paris (Paris Conservatoire).






